# NAAE National Conference

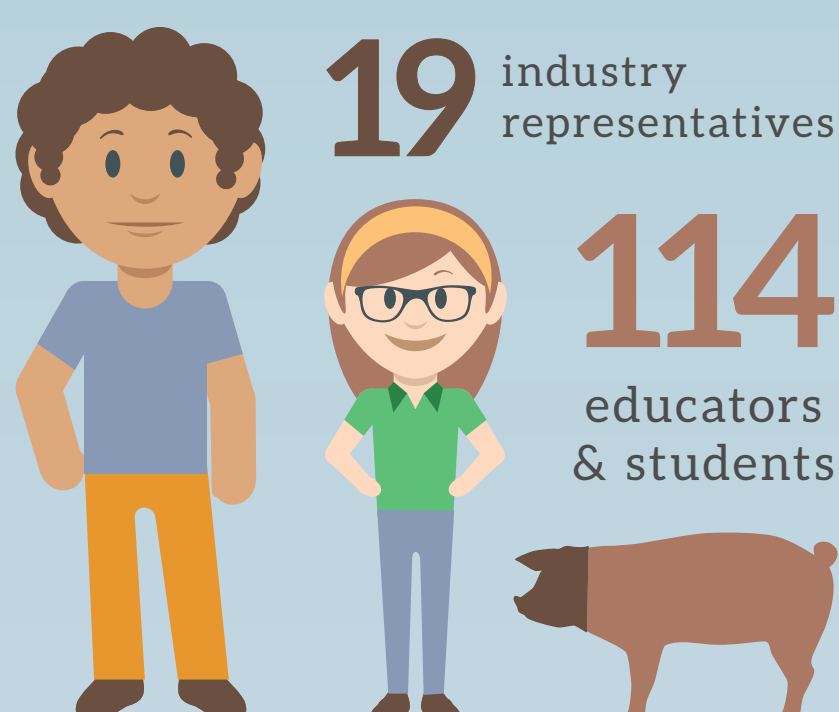
Launceston | Tasmania | January 7-11

Below is a snapshot of the 2018 NAAE National Conference: who was there, what they thought, what they did and how they plan to inspire their students with what they experienced during the four-day event.

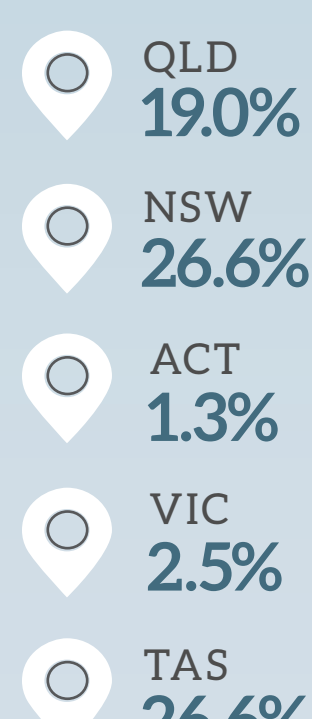
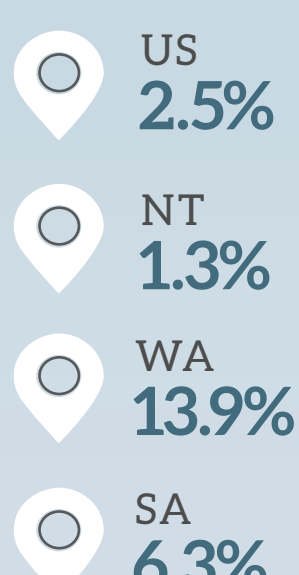
